

 How is 'energy-saving, carbon reduction' experienced and perceived in everyday life?






CONTENT ANALYSIS

- 292 texts: 109 from UD, 114 from LT, 69 from AD
- 67.1% readers' submission;
 69.9% based on selfexperience
- 65.4% by female authors,
 19.5% by male, 15% unknown



"Housewife Saves Energy - I am good at saving money too" United Daily News on July 18 2008

"In addition to cook and prepare lunch boxes [for families], I manage to practice the logic of saving. ... never use air conditioners. Even when it is higher than 30°C, we only use eclectic fans and always unplug them after use. ... I would save bath water to flush the toilet, store discharged water from the washing machine to clean the floor, and wash underwear and dirty clothes by hand. After washing rice, the water would be kept to wash other vegetables, and, after its second use, saved for gardening ..."

- economic recession 2008-2009
- money saving prioritised and became trendy - earth loving, fitting a global trend
- the husband and other family members absent
- labour-intensive and time consuming practices
- · ideal mother/wife remodelled

FAMILY INTERVIEWS

- 10 families interviewed
- age varied from 11 to 75, working to middle class, family types including single, couples with kids, 3 generations in rural and urban settings



ENERGY DIVIDE

"I can't live without air-conditioners. The air-con is on whenever we are home. ... We are older people, and over-weight, when it gets hot, my heart can't bear it. and I will become ill-tempered."

STRESSFUL AND JUGGLING MOTHERS

- grandmas took care of most houseworks her service in exchange of respect
- some husbands mentioned a lot about global warming but not green practitioners at home - mothers and wives in charge of house chores

My son would accuse us for wasting food, not doing energy-saving and carbon-reduction, if we did not eat everything [on the table]. Actually We have been very stressful. ... I wanted to do, but I don't have time.
